
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
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
Quarterly Life Event Elements: PYT Site Young Person Administration When completed: 1st interview during first 30 days from intake. Subsequent interviews every 3 months Period covered: 1st interview covers recent 3 months (not covered by historical interview). Subsequent interviews cover period from previous interview Sources: Direct interviews with youth and young adults or from any other source, such as case files, case-worker knowledge, etc. Format: Paper/pencil, phone, computerized
