



























Summary of Findings Based on Cases of Fatal Child Abuse in Florida Cases are nearly evenly divided between abuse related deaths and neglect related The majority of children in the sample (63%) were at home at the time of death. In 32% of cases either an adult or a child witness was present. In cases of fatal child abuse, female perpetrators are more often involved in cases attributed to neglect while male perpetrators are more likely to engage in physical abuse **USF** leading to the child's death. If the perpetrator is a male then a child is twice more likely to die as a result of abuse versus neglect.
